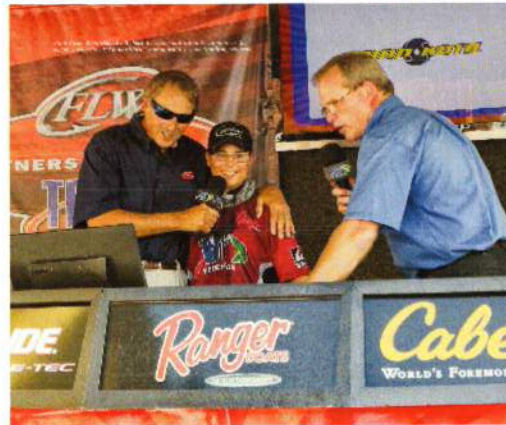


## COMMUNITY & LOCAL CAMPAIGNS

This club is structured into 3 age groups beginning with our TBF "Minnows", our TBF "Juniors" and our Student Athlete Federation or "High School" anglers. ### OUR GOB JUNIOR BASSMASTER'S CLUB

Our G.O.B. Club is divided into 3 age groups. The "Minnows" are youngsters that have not reached the age of 11. They fish from shore only with a single hook and real bait such as worms, crabs & minnows. Our "Junior" anglers are aged 11 to 15 and they fish from a boat using only artificial baits and any hook including treble hooks. Our "High School" anglers (Student Athlete Federation) are youngsters aged 16 to 18 and they too compete using only artificial lures and all our youngsters will be individually guided and instructed accordingly based on angling strengths, knowledge & experience through "how to" clinics and workshops.

Leadership is one of the attributes we instill in our youngsters as they each have a major role in all the associated activities, while the adults are overseeing and guiding their moves. Competition is simply one of the many goals for our "Junior athletes". Conservation, Habitat Restoration, Adopting Waterways, Community Service projects, waterchestnut removal, preserving the wholesome recreational sport of fishing and most importantly - having fun! Youngsters not only learn how to properly catch & release bass, but also learn how to manage their own Club through Parliamentary Procedures, educational workshops, "how-to" clinics and more importantly engage in hands-on activities with their Club Youth Director, other mentors & educators. A benefit for paid up members begin with a \$1 million dollar liability insurance plan that covers each youngster for each scheduled meeting, Club, State and National tournaments, and any TBF events.

Our GOB Junior and our SAF High School anglers each have the opportunity to compete in our annual TBF Invitational's that can result in a \$5,000 dollar college scholarship, prizes and a National Championship.
